

#### VWAP Algo (Best-Efforts)

## Objective

IB's best-efforts VWAP algo seeks to achieve the Volume-Weighted Average price (VWAP), calculated from the time you submit the order to the close of the market.

If you require a guaranteed VWAP, please refer to IB's Guaranteed VWAP order type.

# Important Points

VWAP is calculated from the time you enter the order to the close of the market.


Define the percent of participation of average daily volume up to 50%.

A start time and/or end time dictates when the algo will begin working and end working, regardless of whether or not the entire quantity has been filled.

If an End Time is specified, check *Allow trading past end time* to allow the algo to continue to work past the specified end time if the full quantity has not been filled.

Check Attempt to never take liquidity to discourage the algo order from hitting the bid or lifting the offer if possible. This may help to avoid liquidity-taker fees, and could result in liquidity-adding rebates. However, it may also result in greater deviations from the benchmark, and in partial fills, since the posted bid/offer may not always get hit as the price moves up/down. IB will use best efforts not to take liquidity when this box is checked, however, there will be times that it cannot be avoided.

Results in lower commissions than the Guaranteed VWAP order, but the order may not fully execute and is not guaranteed.
